Everyone is requested to give your call sign using ITU phonetics only, such as Alfa, Bravo, Charley etc., slowly please.

This is K6OX. We would now like to invite AVARC members and guest to log in the order of you callsign suffix only. Please login with your callsign and provide your name, location and whether you have any traffic, comments or questions for the net. Everyone is requested to give your call sign using ITU phonetics only, such as Alfa, Bravo, Charley etc., slowly please.

We will begin with members and guest whose callsign suffix begins with the letters A through F, that's ALPHA through FOXTROT, please check in now.

This is K6OX. Next check in will be for call sign suffix beginning with G through L. That's GOLF through LIMA. Please check in now.

This is K6OX. Next is callsign suffix beginning with the letters M through S. That's MIKE through SIERRA. Please check in now.

This is K6OX. Last, we go to callsign suffix beginning with the letters T through Z. That's TANGO through ZULU. Please check in now.

(Return to those checking in with traffic after the conclusion of the general roll call)
This is K6OX.

We will now ask for late or missed check ins, with or without traffic. Please login with your callsign and provide your name, location and whether you have any traffic, comments or questions for the net. Everyone is requested to give your call sign using ITU phonetics only, such as Alfa, Bravo, Charley etc., slowly please.
